**DESCRIPTION:** This leadership course program of instruction and the accompanying projects and exercises support the Richland One School District. All course materials have been developed in conjunction with the Career and Technology Education Division of Richland One South Carolina Capital Schools District.

**OBJECTIVE:** Utilizing Subject Matter Experts as Assistant Instructors and Guest Speakers, given lectures, handouts, student research, demonstrations and practical exercises, students will demonstrate a full understanding of the principals, characteristics, styles, and requirements of effective leadership and teambuilding by completion of student research projects, student and team presentations, written and practical examinations on which a minimum accuracy of 85% must be achieved.

### **INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES:**

1. Lecture utilizing Power Point and Prizi™ presentations.
2. Group interaction and exercises.
3. Instruction and demonstration on leadership/teambuilding exercises (labs).
4. Instructor and Student after-action briefings on exercises completed.
5. Field Trips.
6. Field exercises for teams.
7. Examinations.
